



## Matthew R. Gutwein

Matthew Gutwein is the only amateur musician in Rock E Bassoon. By day, Matt is the president and chief executive officer of the Health and Hospital Corporation of Marion County (“HHC”), a position he has held since 2003.

Prior to joining HHC, Gutwein practiced law. Gutwein was a partner at Faegre Baker Daniels, adjunct professor of law, Indiana University Maurer School of Law, chief counsel to

Governor Evan Bayh, Special Counsel to Indiana Attorney General Pamela Carter, an associate with Onek, Klein & Farr, and served as a law clerk to the Honorable J. Clifford Wallace, United States Court of Appeals for Ninth Circuit. Gutwein presented oral arguments before the United States Supreme Court in *Heck v. Humphrey*, 512 U.S. 477 (1994) and represented the State of Indiana before the Indiana Court of Appeals, Indiana Supreme Court and United States Supreme Court in *Michael Tyson v. State of Indiana*. Gutwein was named one of Indiana’s Top Ten Super Lawyers.

Gutwein received a J.D. *summa cum laude* from Indiana University Maurer School of Law in 1988 and a B.A. with high honors from Indiana University in 1985.

Gutwein is a native Hoosier and is married to Jane A. Henegar. They have a daughter, Clara Henegar Gutwein.
